

## ▷ ACADEMIC YEAR FELLOWSHIPS

provide tuition and fees, plus a stipend (\$15,000 for graduate students; \$5,000 for undergraduate students). Recipients of academic year FLAS Fellowships are required to take courses at UNM in Nahuatl, Brazilian Portuguese, K'iche' Maya, Quechua, or Quichua, as well as Latin American area studies courses.

## SUMMER FELLOWSHIPS

provide the majority of program fees for intensive study of a lesscommonly-taught Latin American language at a FLAS-eligible program in the US or Latin America. Such languages include Nahuatl, Brazilian Portuguese, K'iche' Maya, Quechua, or Quichua, as well as other indigenous languages of Latin America.
